In 2017 we had 21 rental events in our facility in addition to our camps. Once again this year, these events were held by groups returning as well as introducing new groups to our facility. Our rental clientele continue to be a mix of family, church, school and secular groups.

Continuing in 2017, we received feedback from a few rental groups indicating that our facility needed upgrades in a number of areas. We have taken steps to ensure that we can provide a positive environment and a good experience for both campers and rental groups. Many other comments reflect a positive experience from the food, service and their overall rental experience. This is reflected in our rebooking's along with new word of mouth groups.

We continued to work on our menu options with a view to streamlining our options and an efficient usage of our resources.

Linda Haas has taken over the responsibility of housekeeper and we are thrilled with the work she has been doing around the camp.

Rental rates increased in early 2017 but it will take sometime to come into effect as many groups have already booked under the existing rates. It is our intent to keep current with rental rates to match the increasing costs of food and facility maintenance.
